## RESIDENCY APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- A. All Applicants:
  - ERAS application
  - Dean's letter & medical school transcripts
  - Three letters of recommendation
  - Medical school completion within the last three years; for AY 2021-2022 we will consider applicants with completion dates of 2017 and later
  - Maximum one failure in USMLE Step 1/COMLEX Level 1 and USMLE Step 2-CK/COMLEX Level 2-CE and USMLE Step 2-CS/COMLEX Level 2-PE
- B. California Medical Board Postgraduate Training Letter (PTL) Required for ALL Medical Graduates

California Medical Board Postgraduate Training Letter (PTL) must be obtained within 180 days of starting an ACGME accredited program in California. You may contact the California Medical Board for further information, http://www.mbc.ca.gov/.or at the following:

- C. International Medical Graduates (IMGs). In addition to the requirements listed above, IMGs must have the following:
  - ECFMG Certification

An ECFMG Certificate is required before you will be granted an interview. IMGs who have not yet graduated, must complete the application with the ECFMG. Interviews may be granted to IMGs without an ECFMG Certificate if they are currently enrolled in medical school and they meet the other application criteria. For further information please contact:

D. U.S. Citizenship, Permanent Residency or a valid Employment Authorization Document (EAD) or ECFMG-sponsored J-1 Visa

San Joaquin General Hospital does not sponsor any immigrant or nonimmigrant Visas. Noncitizens will be asked to provide a copy of a document that establishes employment authorization by the date of their interview. IMGs need to contact the ECFMG at the address provided above.
- G. Our next academic year runs from June 26, 2021 through June 30, 2022. We do not have any vacant positions for the 2020-2021 academic year. We offer MS-3 and MS-4 student rotations to qualified medical students.
- H. All applications are due by November 30, 2020. We are part of the UC Davis Network of Affiliated Family Medicine Residency Programs. All our interviews are arranged through SJGH Program Coordinator, Anna Hernandez. Interviews will be conducted November 05 through December 28, 2020. Our interviews start at 8:00 am and end by 12:00 pm.
